FAQ: Investiture/Rededication at Knott's Berry Farm Celebrating International Day of The Girl



What are the Investiture & Rededication Ceremonies in Girl Scouts?

A Girl Scout **investiture** ceremony welcomes new Girl Scout members, while a **rededication** ceremony celebrates returning members as they renew their commitment to the Girl Scout Promise and Law. Honor your Girl Scout milestones by observing this day together with a meaningful ceremony and interactive Knott's Berry Farm activity highlighting women who impacted history!

What is International Day of The Girl?

The International Day of the Girl address the challenges girls face worldwide and promotes girls' empowerment and fulfilment of human rights, all in celebration of sisterhood! Girls will also explore Knott's Berry Farm in a park-wide celebration of women's impact of settlement and history through the Knott's Adventures in Education program!

Does my whole troop need to attend for my daughter to go? Do parents attend?

Troops and/or parent/Girl Scout pairs can attend this event even if only a few girls, or one girl, from the troop wants to go. Adults are responsible for appropriate adult-girl ratios at all times. All paid participants stay together for the entire day.

Can multi-level troops attend together?

You are welcome to register all members of your troop. Troops will be grouped together.

When does registration close?

This event will be open until full, or until 9/28/2022.

What is the event schedule?

7:30-checkin; 8am-breakfast & characters; 9am-ceremony; 9:45 tours; 11am-park free time to 5pm.

What should we wear and bring?

Girl Scouts traditionally wear uniforms/sash/vest for GS ceremonies. For the park, bring layers and a refillable water bottle. Comfortable shoes a must!

Do I need to pay if I have an annual pass?

Annual pass holders may apply a discount at time of registration and can enter with an annual pass.

Does this event accept cookie dough or credits?

Yes! GSOC girls can register for the event first, then complete a <u>Redemption Form</u> to be reimbursed.

How can family view the ceremony & program?

This event is for registered Girl Scouts and adults only. Family & siblings may celebrate in the park with the troop after the program concludes at 11am

Can we bring SWAPS?

YES! We encourage you to bring approx. 50 <u>SWAPS</u>. The best time to swap will be as the girls arrive, and during breakfast. See ideas on Pinterest!

What is included with registration?

Each registration includes catered breakfast, character photos, ceremony, patch, Adventure in Education Tour, and park free time until 5pm.

Can out of council Girl Scouts register?

Yes! Non-members or out of council Girl Scouts pay an increase of \$10 to cover council service fees.

Are there Covid-19 guidelines for this event?

GSOC follows current CDC COVID-19 guidelines. While masks are not required, the CDC recommends "individuals wear a well-fitting mask indoors in public, regardless of vaccination status or individual risk (including in K-12 schools and other community settings)" while in the high transmission period. Event participants will be notified if additional action is required.
